It is two years since I last judged this breed and having been involved in this breed since the mid seventies, a king Charles Spaniel should be compact and cobby as there are far too many shown nowadays looking more like Cavalier King Charles Spaniels in shape.

Puppy Dog (7 Entries) (Absent: 1)

1st: Mochrie's - Downsbank Razzle Dazzle Em

Tri with a super head, good round large dark eye and desired soft expression, has the most lovely finish to muzzle with the right amount of cushioning, excellent neck and good shoulder placement, right for size, with level topline, both standing and moving, just hope he gains more confidence, if he does, should gain his crown Best Dog Puppy & Best Puppy In Breed

2nd: Champion's – Lankcombe Ambassador

Nicely marked tricolour and bright tan, attractive head with dark eye and nicely cushioned fore-face, well placed low set ears, well made with short cobby body, moved well and has a lovely temperament.

3rd: Gillhespy & McInally – Lorphil Treasure Island

Junior Dog (8 Entries) (Abs: 1)

1st: Jackson's - Amantra Regal Duke

Tri, masculine head, with pleasing expression, good reach of neck slightly arched, leading into well placed shoulders, lovely bone, legs well placed under body, sound quarters, cobby and compact body, moved soundly, another exhibit that was presented and shown in very good condition.

2nd: Mochrie's - Downsbank Kismet

Tri with excellent tan markings, pleasing head, good width of muzzle and nice dark eyes, pleasing front, just right for bone, correct topline, sound quarters, just lost to winner on majority. Put down in very nice condition as were all from this kennel.

2rd Gillhespy – Joshua De Melcourt (IMP FRA)

Post Graduate Dog (8 Entries)

1st: Jackson's - Amantra Treasury

Blenheim with rich chestnut markings, lovely head with high rise skull, broad muzzle, dark eyes, and good low set ears, well constructed with round rib cage, well laid shoulders well angulated rear quarters, cobby body and compact, moved very soundly with level topline. If this dog just settled and gave a little more when showing, he would be a strong contender for top honours, presented in very nice condition.

2nd: Clarke's – Stonepit Super Sydney For Poltomic
Well marked tricolour with rich tan markings in all the right places,
pleasing head with nice rise to skull
good width to muzzle, well balanced outline and good bone and
substance, level topline, moved soundly in both directions,
presented in excellent condition.

3rd Water's - Peakdowns Wellington TAF

Limit Dog (5 Entries) (Abs: 1)

1st: Coupland's - Tucherish High Treason

Tri. Masculine head, with large round dark eyes, good rise to skull and low set ears that were well feathered, good reach of neck, good bone and substance, ample neck with slight arch, into well placed shoulders, cobby and compact body with chest deep with super topline and hindquarters, moved out soundly, well bent stifles, producing a free effortless gait, quality silky straight coat. I gave him the reserve CC when I last judged him as a puppy, today he was fully mature so I was pleased to award him his 3rd CC. This dog was put down to perfection and presented in super condition. 2nd: Smith's - Headra's Truly Magic Is Justacharma

Tri. Pleasing head, he was lovely to go over on the table, he scores in outline and is so well balanced, excellent bone and substance and sound quarters, this dog must be one of the best movers here today, and really was a joy to watch him with free flowing action and excellent topline, silky coat of the right texture which was presented in very good condition.

3rd: Byers - Paulian Ernest With Simannie

Open Dog (3 Entries)

1st: Mochrie's - Ch Downsbank Gutherie JW

Well marked tricolour with rich tan, quality head and expression, very typy and sound, nice size, good depth of body, excellent topline and croup, lovely shoulders and good bone, moved soundly and typical gait, quality coat and shown in tip top condition. I have always admired this dog, if he just gave that little more; just does enough and wished he had more animation when showing, truly quality dog that looked the part. Reserve Dog CC

2nd: Sproul & Coburn's – Baldragon Berkeley For Khandro Lightly marked tricolour, another quality dog, with good high rise skull, large dark eyes, good width of muzzle and low set ear placement, medium arched neck, good depth of chest, well boned with good forequarters, just not as mature as winner, shown in very nice condition and was very stylish on the move.

3rd: Bailey's - Aldoricka The Maverick

Puppy Bitch (5 Entries)

1st: Mochrie's - Downsbank Betsy Trotwood

Blen. feminine pleasing head with large round dark expressive eyes, good front, ample reach of neck, nice bone, would prefer a better topline, moved well and won this class as she was much more mature. Best Puppy Bitch

2nd: Rushton's - Justacharma Magic Made For Tiflin

Tri. Another nice youngster lovely eye and expression, good reach of neck, with level topline, took everything in her stride and has a lovely temperament, really enjoyed herself and wanted to please her handler who just lost out on maturity.

3rd: Sproul & Coburn's - Sugar Plum Pie For Khandro

Junior Bitch (1 Entries)

1st: Jackson's - Amantra Regalia

Tri. feminine good head with correct dome, with large round dark expressive eyes, good front with ample bone and substance, arched neck with level topline, well let down hocks, producing a free effortless movement, another from this kennel that was cobby and compact quality coat and shown in lovely condition. Reserve CC

Post Graduate Bitch (2 Entries)

1st: Matches – Khandro La Vie En Rose From Fochai Lightly marked tri with rich tan, well domed head, low set ears, good reach neck, clean shoulders, good quarters and retained topline on the move, well carried tail, nice size and well balanced covering the ground with rhythmical propulsion. With a little more majority could go to the top I considered her for the reserve cc but just lost out to the junior winner on coat. Shows with lots of piazz and has a lovely temperament shown in lovely condtion.

2nd: Coupland's - Tucherish Julie Christie

Tri. feminine head with high rise and good dome, low set ears, good length of rib, good reach of neck, her movement was sound, lost out to winner on topline, would be an advantage to lose a little weight, presented in lovely condition with straight silky coat of the right textured.

Limit Bitch (2 Entries)

1st: Byers - Simannie Sweet Anneka

Tri. with rich tan feminine head with good dome and large round dark eyes, such a lovely typy, super outline, good neck, good dome, straight front, neck and shoulders flow into level topline and tailset, good width to muzzle, moved very soundly, quality coat and shown in lovely condition.

2nd: Champion's - Stonepit Lillian Gist At Lankcombe

Tri. Another quality exhibit that oozes type, lovely head large dark eyes, correct low set ears, compact body, excellent topline, good depth of ribcage, well balanced liked her size, lost out to winner on presentation, such a shame as I like her alot.

Open Bitch (2 Entries)

1st: Willey & Siddle's - Ch Penemma Misty For Me JW

Blenhiem with excellent finish to head high rise skull which is more difficult to achieve in this colour oozes type, very feminine head with large round dark expressive eyes, low set ears, good reach of neck, straight front and well angulated quarters, moved with style and so sound with excellent spirit level topline, giving good drive and sound movement level topline, with excellent set tail, well bent stifle and hocks well let down, producing a free effortless gait, quality coat and shown in superb condition. 2nd: Mochrie's - Downsbank Evensong

Tri feminie head with dark round eyes, good dome, compact and cobby body, good front and well angulated quarters, level topline moved soundly with outgoing temperament lots to like and I note she is the dam of my reserve cc winner.
