### Veteran Dog or Bitch (8)(2)

1st Goodwin's – Lanola Moreneta, B/T bitch, full of breed type, well-domed skull, clear large dark eyes and wide nostrils, medium neck into well laid shoulders, short legs on a cobby body, moved freely keeping her topline, looked exceptional at 10 years. Best Veteran In Show

2nd Champion's – Lankcombe Miss Money Penny, well marked pretty blen, nearly 8 years, and nice shaped head with low set ears, short back and level topline, and moved well.

3rd Austin's - Baldragon Bootylicious

## Minor Puppy Dog. (3)(1)

1st Mochrie's – Downsbank Kismet, well marked 7 month old tri, very promising, well domed head with low set ears, gentle expression with large dark eyes, nicely cushioned, well laid shoulders into a cobby body, four sound legs, firm croup and good drive from the rear, I loved him, Best Dog Puppy & Best Puppy In Show

2nd Baker's – Cofton Morning Town Ride, another very promising tri almost 7 months, nicely marked and eye-catching, quality head, compact body, firm elbows, just not as developed as 1 today.

#### Puppy Dog. (2)(1)

1st Salguero's – Rivermoor Minstrel, 11 month old tri, quality headpiece with large dark eyes and open nostrils, level topline on the move, straight forelegs, well let down hocks, could be more compact and needs to body up. Time is on his side for improvement.

### Junior Dog. (3)

1st Essex's – Chacombe Royal Gift To Brendek, quality tri of 17 months, pleasing head with large dark eyes and good nostrils, square muzzle with wide jaw, very mature in body with straight forelegs and muscled hindquarters, moved freely with elegance, well presented.

2nd Salguero's - Rivermoor Minstrel.

### Graduate Dog. (2)(1)

1st Champion's – Stonepit Buster Keyton At Lankcombe, I liked this tri boy, possesses a lovely head with good features, width to jaw, good lay of shoulder into straight forelegs with elbows close to ribs, level topline on a well covered body, moved with drive but unfortunately carried his tail high.

## Post Graduate Dog. (4)

1st Mochrie's – Downsbank Montgomery, this blen male typifies 'Charlie' through and through, a blen of highest quality, rise to head with low set ears, muzzle wide and deep and width to jaw, very well constructed with excellent topline, reserved temperament but wish he would give a little more and enjoy his day out. Reserve Best Dog

2nd Schemel's – Tudorhurst Firestone, larger blen mature male of good type, nicely marked, not quite the head nor expression of winner, but I liked his construction and soundness, lovely presentation.

3rd Saguero's - Downsbank Fletcher

Limit Dog. (3)(1)

1st Wallhead's – Sleepyhollow Trikki Dikki At Merida, a well marked tri I have judged before and liked, nice headed with square muzzle, arched neck carried proud, well developed body, soundness throughout which allowed him to move with so much elegance.

2nd Moss's – Vashdown Top Of The Scale Mit Sombur, very heavily marked tri, pleasing head with large dark eyes and open nostrils, well bodied and sound.

## Open Dog. (5)(2)

1st Ryan's – IR CH/INT CH/CH Charnell Brando At Cavalli, I have admired this blen before he started hitting the limelight, lovely head with good rise to skull, large dark eyes with large wide open nostrils, square in muzzle well turned up, arched neck into well laid shoulders, perhaps a trifle too wide in chest, but this did not affect his front movement, level topline, enough covering on body and muscled hindquarters to give soundness and drive from the rear, well marked, prepared and in lovely coat and feathering to win a very well deserved Best Dog & Best In Show 2nd Mochrie's – Bonitos Companeros Deluxe High Society, a lovely headed tri, typical expression with lovely large dark eyes set wide apart, nice

cushioning, well developed body but a tad longer than 1, very sound and lots to like in good condition.

## Minor Puppy Bitch. (2)(1)

1st Mochrie's – Downsbank Betsy Trotwood, a super blen, well marked, stood alone but surely deserved her win, well domed skull, with that true Charlie expression, dark eyes, sound in front, level back with good tail carriage, well bent stifles, was a little reluctant on the move, but I liked her a lot, a good type.

# Puppy Bitch. (3)

1st Havey's – Rivermoor Lady Martha, a beautiful fem blen, almost 12 months with a mod large head, well domed and good facial features, low set ears, nicely made with tight elbows, short legs, sufficient bend of stifle which enabled her to move

with drive from behind, would like her more compact but quality, condition and breed type won her Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve Best Puppy In Show

2nd Mochrie's – Downsbank Soliloquy, another top quality puppy from this kennel, tri of 10 months, well domed skull with large dark eyes, well laid shoulders, very cobby with short sound legs, moved soundly, needs more time to mature, I liked her a lot. 3rd Ryan's – Carleeto Madame Butterfly of Cavalli

### Graduate Bitch. (5)(1)

1st Champion's – Stonepit Lilian Glist At Lankcombe, a lovely tri, quality head shape and features, well marked with good tan, level topline, short legs, cobby body that could do with a trifle more covering, loved her standing and moving, lacked the presentation of top winners.

2nd Dix's – Beewye Precious Perdita, pretty little tri, very feminine, would not behave on the table, nicely domed skull with true Charlie expression, well bodied and moved with excitement, enjoying her day out for sure.

3rd Juniper's - Lewiscarol Black Beauty

## Post Graduate Bitch (5)(1)

1st Wallhead's – Baldragon Becuz I'm Worth It To Merida, nice headed tri, judged her before and has now matured well, lacked body before, but now has sufficient covering, good bone, cobby and showed extremely well, very sound but moved a little close behind.

2nd Dix's – Beewye Penelope Pitstop, lightly marked tri, very similar in temperament to sister in last class, well domed head, large dark eyes, cobby in body and sound, eventually her short legs managed to move properly to be assessed.

3rd Juniper's - Lewiscarol Lady In Red

## Limit Bitch. (7)(2)

1st Stone's – Maynorth Back To Black, gorgeous headed b/t with desired low set ears, old fashioned in type, large dark eyes with a wide deep muzzle and correct up turn. Straight forelegs with tight elbows, well bodied with level topline, ultra sound with

typical Charlie movement, wish she was a tad shorter in body length.

2nd Robinson's – Baldragon Tantrum An Tiaras, lovely type tri I have given a BP to before, well domed skull with dark eyes and nose with open nostrils, sound in front, cobby body with good turn of stifle, moved freely and soundly, wish she had more clothes on.

3rd Mochrie's - Downsbank Glimpse Trotwood

**Open Bitch.** (8)(2)

1st Goodwin's – CH Maibee Clementine Of Lanola ShCM, one of the best Maibee bitches for sure and reminds me of Ch. Carolina, lightly marked tri with a flawless head, so well domed and captivating expression, darkest of eyes and well open nostrils, ideal size and shape with legs short, cobby body, well turned stifles and hocks well let down, looked like a neat little package and showing her heart out, not in her best clothes yet, could not deny her Best Bitch & Best Opposite Sex

2nd Baker's – Cofton Walking On Sunshine, another tri from the top drawer who I liked a lot, domed head with excellent features, good pigment, cobby body on four short legs, well marked with tan in all the right places, very sound mover and most unlucky to meet 1. Not disgraced here to win Reserve Best Bitch

**3rd Essex's – Tudorhurst Beatrice at Brendek** 

Special Open (B/T or Ruby) Dog or Bitch (4)(1)

1st Stone's – Maynorth Fallen From Heaven, a ruby b of nice type, pleasing head with dark eyes, open nostrils, well bodied and ample bone, moved soundly and deserved her win here despite leaving her best clothes at home.

2nd Juniper's – Lewiscarol Lady Divine 3rd Sellen's – Levicos Ladette To Lady
