BP; 2 Mochrie's Downsbank Razzle Dazzle Em, tri, very close up to first with good bone, promising shape to head with width, again nice bone, just looked a little immature on the day; 3 Gillhespy's Joshua De Melcourt.
- **JD** (2) 1 Jackson's Amantra Summer Promise, a lovely headed tri, well made dog, moved OK; 2 Kendall & Askins' Jameson Azzaro Fapella Gray, nicely made young tri, just preferred head of 1st.
- **PGD** (6) 1 Mochrie Downsbank Montgomery, my surprise of the day, nice head, lovely pigment, good ribs, short loin, shoulders sloping with return, quarters were good, what I liked was his lovely bone & strong pasterns, & straight front, keeping straight topline at all times, blen. CC & BOB; 2 Moffat's Maibee Horatio, tri, again a nice dog, good head & conformation, not the finish of the 1st; 3 Gillhespy's Gmacrystals Red Garnet.
- **LD** (6) 1 Coupland's Tucherish High Treason, a lovely headed tri, nicely marked, good ribs, short loin, made well, moved well, to me the CC winner was more together on the day. RCC; 2 Swanston's Corrinwood Crusoe of Pamojil, blen, nice headed dog, just preferred the lips & movement to the winner; 3 Champion's Stonepit Buster Keeton at Lankcombe.
