My only if would be I wish he had a brighter tan; 2 Matches' Baldragon Striding Edge to Fochai, richly marked blen, well proportioned body, good head, well set dark eyes, nice nose placement, sound back & front; 3 Smith's Headra's Truly Magic Is Justacharma.

Her coat whilst of correct texture I would have liked less flecked; 3 Robinson's Baldragon Tantrum An Tiaras.

PGB (3) 1 Gillhespy's Downsbank Designed for Lorphil, really lovely blen, should become a ch. Richly marked coat, good bone, lovely size, cobby body, good spring of rib, nice legs & feet. Unlucky to meet the CC winner, had she had a touch more fringes on ears she would have had the big green card. RCC; 2 Askins & Kendall's Headra's Caverswall, a bitch I like very much. Well marked blen. Not as deep in colour as 1 but many of same remarks would apply; 3 Cox's Headra's Chocolate Brownie at Churchchis.

LB (5) 1 Robinson's Baldragon All About Me, top class, well broken tri, wonderful breed type, good head, lovely eyes, good bone, ideal size. Moves well but perhaps a little would spring her rib. Lovely bitch; 3 Anderson& Watt's Nisyros Atlanta.
