VD (1) 1 Kendall, Askins & Vallila's Ch UK Fin Int Ch Headra's Chocolate D Lite Re, beautiful masculine head with soft expression, sound front & rear angulation, moving soundly with good topline at all times, presented in good order.

MPD (5) 1 Gillhespy's Lorphil Red River, promising ruby, lovely head & expression, good ear placement, sound front, body & ribs, moves true fore & aft; 2 Melville's Amantra Chorale, nice size & quality, masculine head, good balance & bone, shows well, needs to mature a little more in body; 3 Stewart's Kasamanda Just A Dream for Marchog.

PD (3) 1 Gillhespy & McInally's Lorphil Treasure Island, smart youngster with loads of promise, cobby & compact in body, sound front & rear, good head & expression, moves true. BP; 2 Byers' Lanola Giorgio Armani, appealing head, well made body of correct size & proportions, moves sound, just needs confidence; 3 Robinson's Baldragon Brecon.

JD (3) 1 Miller & Ryan's Amantra Regius of Feorlig, compact & cobby, fits the standard well, good front, ribs & topline, good turn of stifle, sound happy showman.

RCC; 2 Jackson's Amantra Regal Prince, quality tri, very sound & full of type, correct size & balance, jsut needs time; 3 Clarke's Stonepit Bobby Dazzler at Poltomic.

PGD (8,2a) 1 Sprould & Coburn's Khandro No Regrets, masculine head with good cushioning & expression, nice coat & condition, moves straight & sound; 2 Maddison's Penemma Raphael, compact blen, balanced in head & body, level topline & tail carriage, covers the ground with ease; 3 Gillhespy's Gmacrystals Red Garnet.

LD (8,2) 1 Gillhespy's Yakee Royal Treasure, richly coloured, well marked handsome young dog, good domed head, dark eyes & well set ears, good reach of neck & well laid shoulders, body is sturdy & cobby with level

topline, excellent front & rear angulation which give him very sound true action. CC, BOB; 2 Jackson's Amantra Treasury, nice blen with good bone, lovely masculine head, compact in body, very good action, not as outgoing as 1; 3 Clarke's Stonepit Super Sydney for Poltomic. OD (7,1) 1 Byers' Paulian Ernest with Simannie, well presented tri, good head, dark eye & good markings, cobby body, nice ribs & topline, black marking all down one black leg, does spoil overall appearance & would like more tan under tail; 2 Ryan's Ch Ir Int Ch Charnell Brando at Cavalli, blen of nice size & proportions, pleasing head & expression, movement could be a little tighter; 3 Coupland's Ch Tucherish High Treason.

VB (1) 1 Bailey's Maibee Margot at Aldoricka, feminine & appealing in head, good front, neat body, well presented silky coat, moves soundly. BV.

MPB (2) 1 Sproul & Coburn's Sugar Plum Pie for Khandro, cute puppy, good front & tight elbows, well bodied for age, moves & shows well; 2 Luke's Midnight Moonbeam, feminine ruby, good shape & balance, just needs time.

PB (1) 1 Goodwin's Lanola Mademoiselle, lightly marked tri, short & cobby, nice expression & dark eye, balanced on the move.

JB (6,2) 1 Jackson's Amantra Regalia, a lovely tri, well marked, short level back, cobby & compact with good bone, feminine head with good dome & lovely expression, moves sound. RCC; 2 Gurtner's Josephine De Melcourt, a truly feminine tri, correct size & balance, compact in body with good topline, such a beautiful head & expression, moves true & sound, with a little more confidence will trouble the best; 3 Johnson's Headra's Pennywise at Alambra.

PGB (3,1) 1 Harvey's Rivermoor Lady Martha, pretty blen, classic head with good dome & large dark eyes, good front & chest, neat elbows, firm body, just needs a little more confidence; 2 Kendall, Askins & Vallila's

Sandstrand Merituuli at Headra, smart tri of good proportions & balance, neat body, silky coat, well presented.

LB (3) 1 Dix's Beewye Penelope Pitstop, nice feminine tri of good size & correct bone, moves soundly & holds her topline on the move, attractive head, well cushioned muzzle, well presented; 2 Coupland's Tucherish Julie Christie, typy tri, well constructed overall, feminine head & expression, but needs more confidence; 3 Byers' Simannie Sweet Anneka.

OB (4) 1 Willey & Siddle's Ch Penemma Misty For Me, pretty head with melting expression, scores in body & topline, correct angles front & rear, covers the round with ease; 2 Robinson's Ch Baldragon She Demands, nicely shaped tri, good neck, front & shoulders, cobby & firm body, shows well; 3 Gillhespy's Ch Downsbank Designed for Lorphil.
