- MPD (2) 1 Hodges Marchog Monopoly, 6 months, bit unco-ordinated at rear at present. Lovely head & earset low, good jaw & cheeks well filled, short body. Needs time. Moved quite well; 2 Pascoe S Cwmtirion Aint Behaven, pretty tri, longer in body & needs more over loin. Spoils topline on the move but free action. Time will tell.
- PD (1) 1 Robinson & Austin s Baldragon Hooray Henley, 9 months blen, over the top for size for me. Good depth of brisket & nice tailset. Slightly plain in head.
- JD (1) 1 B Hooray Henley.
- PGD (6) 1 Waters & Robins Maibee Teddie, tri, such a typical specimen, short coupled, beautiful rise over skull, wide nostrils, lovely eyes & well filled cheeks. Ears hang flat, well set on tail, nice neck, shoulders & topline, straight front, good feet, in smashing condition, delightful temperament. Pushed hard for CC. RCC; 2 Leach S Amantra Carte Blanche, nice blen boy, smaller eye & longer cast. Free mover & good depth of brisket, pleasing skull; 3 Quartermain S Downsbank Mr Bo Jangles with Cutel.
- LD (4,1a) 1 Smith s Justacharma He Is Our Magic, very free moving blen, enough of him but not over the top. Well balanced throughout, lovely head & ears, good stop & nose, in good coat & frill, a nice all round typical KCS. Panting a little which can spoil expression. CC; 2 Schilizzis Rosspenn Fudge Brownie of Chacombe, needs more coat but rich ruby with good face properties. Larger eyes would improve. Cobby body & moved freely; 3 Austins Baldragon Big It Up.
 OD (3) 1 Lloyds Cwmhaf Forty Second Street, preferred width of skull & jaw of 1 who moved quite well; 2 Stewarts Marchog MacFlannel, lovely rich ruby, just slightly less width of jaw

which for me spoilt expression but close decision; 3 Healey s Chacombe Jackson.

- MPB (1) 1 Goodwin s Lanola Amy Winehouse, very immature tri pup, just 6 months & it shows. Short coupled & lovely domed skull, ears placed well, good jaw, strong front. Bit by bit has good qualities, just needs to develop. BP.
- PB (1) 1 Johnson s Alambra Voo Doo, 10 months b/t, if only she would stop shoovering the floor she would probably look quite nice. Lovely domed skull, full cheeks, good nose & stop, long ears, in super condition. Hopefully practice will help.
- JB (6,2) 1 Fox-Shone s Amantra Charlene, well balanced extrovert tri, lovely head, beautiful eyes, nice size, moved well, straight front. Needs a little more maturity to complete the picture but very promising; 2 Phillips Kasamanda Waltzing Matilda, left her clothes at home. Blen, has to be handled to appreciate her qualities. Nice skull; 3 Williams Kasamanda My Lady Fayre. PGB (10,1) 1 Waters & Robins Maibee Olivia, blen, just lovely typy KCS, super outline, good neck, carrying a noble head, straight front, neck & shoulders flow into topline & tailset, gorgeous face, cheeks well filled, lovely mouth, superb condition & delightful temperament. RCC; 2 Smith s Justacharma Something Magic, blen, full of life, liked her very much, straight front & good width of jaw; 3 Bailey s Maibee Margot at Aldoricka.
- LB (9) 1 Waters & Robins Maibee Leah, tri, fine exhibit, such quality & typical from this handler, lovely domed skull, low set long ears, gorgeous eyes, rise, stop, expression, wide jaw, straight front, good feet, compact body & depth of brisket, tail well set on, good shoulders, smashing condition, moved freely. CC & BOB: 2 Goodwin s Lanola Moreneta, b/t, so much to like, moves well, very typy; 3 Williams Kasamanda My Sweet Charity.
- OB (4) 1 Allcock s Amantra Christiania for Sleepyhollow, tri, very feminine, typy, pleasing size & balance. Hind action could be better; 2 Mallows Lorphil Copper Delight Binglui, ruby, built on larger mould & longer cast. Pleasing head & in top condition; 3 Southams Cavella Callula.
