- MPD (4) 1 Quartermain s Downsbank Mister Bo Jangles, 6 months & obviously immature but very promising. Good rise in skull, well cushioned muzzle, low set ears, forward looking eyes, sturdy body for age & quite sound;
- 2 Tarabad & Tarabad s Lillijay Percy Cute Khatibi, more mature but not quite the dome in skull of 1. Level lips, eyes a wee bit small. Happy chap, moving out well; 3 Navlor s Maenan Moon Blaze.
- PD (3) 1 Maddison s Alambra Rich Ruby, moves close behind & more muscle would improve his rear action. Nice free stride in profile, sturdy boy, well boned, pleasing head & muzzle, good expression, true front. A wee bit long in loin perhaps. Shows well; 2 L Percy Cute Khatibi;
- 3 Askins & Askins Headra S Chocolate D Lite.
- JD (2) 1 Pearce S Vinvaldi Black Knight, needs to be a bit bolder & more outgoing. Good size & proportions, excellent head & layback of muzzle, nose placement & forehand correct, looks better moving than hunching himself up standing. Sound; 2 Summer S Othmese Dho Kynance at Kingsleigh, has the lovely temperament of the breed but is a little too tall & shelly, pins in going away & very curly in coat. Liked his head & firm muzzle, low set ears, rich tan & happy wagging tail.
- PGD (6) 1 Mochrie s Downsbank Breugal, beautiful head & skull, liquid eyes, level lips, medium length neck. Front legs could be a little straighter. Good body & proportions of height to length, well set tail, good pigment, keeps outline moving;

- 2 Maddison s Tucherish Angelo, eyes a bit too prominent & cuts up sharply in underline. Good for size & balance, well boned, happy temperament. Front legs could be straighter. Lovely coat & condition;
- 3 Mansfield Rossbonny Harvey.
- LD (8) Lovely class. 1 Stewart s Marchog MacFlannel, neat ruby, pleasing head, level lips, well open nostrils, nicely set, good eye placement & excellent pigment, true, sound front, compact body, enough bend of stifle. Moves a little close going away otherwise difficult to fault. CC;
- 2 Portingale s Tudorhurst Brigadier, super temperament, little broader in skull but well open nostrils, nicely cushioned muzzle, strong neck & body. Roaches up a trifle on the table but levels out moving. Good bone & compact feet, lovely rich colour;
- 3 Schillizi s Rosspenn Fudge Brownie of Chacombe.
- OD (10) 1 Fry s Ch Check Mate Amantra, great to go over for type, balance, sturdy body & the most attractive head, eyes & expression. Thought his coat could be silkier & not so curly but otherwise a lovely boy who moves so well. RCC;
- 2 Stewart s Kasamanda Celtic Connexion to Marchog, beautiful head, deep black pigment, well placed eyes. Not quite the front or rear movement of 1 but holds a correct level topline & is beautifully marked with lovely silky coat;
- 3 Byers Ch Maynorth Carnival at Simannie.
- MPB (5) Promising class but they were very immature. 1 Naylor s Maenan Moon Angel, the most together on the day, beautiful head for age, although nose is set in a little too much. Soundly made & moves nicely, well boned, holds herself proudly;

- 2 Schilizzis Chacombe Margie Faye, promising girl. Needs lead training & time of course. Nice to go over, lovely pigment, pleasing domed skull, low set ears; 3 Irelands Charnell Only Hope.
- PB (6) Two lovely puppies. 1 Austin S Cofton Bop To The Top, scrumptious head & personality, well cushioned muzzle, nicely set nose, good front, bone & tidy feet, excellent topline & moves reasonably well for age, lovely silky coat coming. BP; 2 Stanbury Inixia Love Affair, well marked blen, appealed in head, eyes & expression is soft & melting, OK in front. Just has a tendency to run up, probably a temporary thing as she grows, great temperament;
- 3 Smith s Justacharma Something Magic.
- JB (6) 1 C Bop To The Top;
- 2 Byers Simannie Precious Gemstone, gorgeous head & well domed skull, pleasing proportions of head to muzzle, OK in neck & front, level back, well bent stifles & neat hocks. Moves very close in rear. Holds herself nicely in profile. Lightly marked blen; 3 Scovell Manaking Miss Kitty of Levicos.
- PGB (8,1) 1 Pascoe & Pascoe s Cwmhaf Aint Misbehavin at Cwmtirion, slightly heavy marked tri, lovely head, low carriage of ears framing her face, good size, well boned, deep & nicely ribbed back, fair mover, in good body & coat;
- 2 Mochrie s Downsbank Julietta, extrovert who flings herself all over! Appealed for head. Maybe not quite the width of muzzle of 1. Lovely body & correct topline, well set & carried tail, nicely broken markings;
- **3 Stone** Maynorth Irresistible.

LB (10,3) 1 Fry & Jackson s Amantra Winterberry, only the second Charlie of the entry to have any muscletone so far. It does improve movement & drive. This girl is lovely in head, lustrous eyes, medium neck, sound legs & feet, well ribbed & a level back. Her up & down movement could be truer but otherwise a beauty. RCC;

2 Williams Kasamanda My Sweet Charity, not in such good coat as 1 but a sweet face. Good domed skull, moved well especially in rear. A touch longer in loin maybe; 3 Baker Cofton I Dreamed A Dream.

OB (7,3) 1 Southam@s Cavella Callula, nicely muscled girl, soundly constructed, pleasing head & beautiful eyes, good size, feminine yet still sturdy in build, rich colour, correct topline & movement, real star. CC & BOB:

2 Williams Kasamanda My Fair Lady, sparky girl, very sound, moving & pretty in head. Her coat not quite as pleasing as it could be & lom sure in better coat she would do extremely well. Really nice quality bitch;

3 Mochrie s Downsbank Hazel.
