- PD (2) Two dramatically different dogs. I Rexlands Ambassador, 7 months tri rather rangy at this stage & needs to be more compact, but very mobile. Head shows promise, but needs to develop some more dome. Good turn-up of nose & underjaw, wide jaws, well cushioned, well balanced mover; 2 Downsbank Mistc Bo jangles with Cutel, 9 months tri, attractive head with good dome, but prefer more width of underjaw. Well placed shoulders, compact body, moved well. At this age could be more masculine & is rather low stationed.
- JD (I) I Amantra Cart Blanche, very mobile blen, nice dome, well placed nose & expressive eyes. Prefer some more turn-up of underjaw. Adequate neck & front angulation. As typical of the breed, he will need quite a lot of time to develop in body. Attractive silhouette but falls away a little too much over the croup. Still strides out well from the side needs to stabilize in front movement. Excellent coat & colour. PGD (2) I Palandro Winter Robin at Raytrix, masculine tri, strong, masculine head, acceptable dome good turn-up of nose & underjaw, square & wide in muzzle, moderately high earset strong neck, enough angulation in front, firm topline. Prefer more compactness moved well; 2 Tucherish The Black Knight at Fochai, b/t with excellent dome, bul prefer some more width of muzzle which is ultra short, beautiful eyes, very moderate neck, good return of upper arm, compact body. Tended to lose balance on the move, becoming low in front & high behind. Excellent coat & colour. LD (3) I Justacharma He Is Our Magic, compact blen, the star of the day, his head is just large enough, but fits his body. Scores in dome, turn-up of nose & cushioning. Very

upturned in underjaw, no more undershot required. Strong neck, well angulated, excellent topline, cobby in proportions & very attractive in his silhouette, beautiful coat & colour, excelled in side movement & moved quite well coming & going too. BOB; 2 Tiflin Tudor Royal, typy tri, very good dome, well turned-up nose, but could have more turn-up of underjaw, borderline bite. Large & expressive eyes, even if they could be somewhat darker. Well placed ears, well developed in body, pleasing back & loin, but falling away more over the croup than I prefer. Moved with pleasing balance from the side, toeing in in front. RBD; 3 Tucherish Florison of Fochai.

- PB (4) I Maibee Margot, very attractive blen, typy & well developed for age, appealed in head, excellent dome, width of muzzle, well placed nose, excellent expression, balanced angulation, well developed body. Please teach her to move as she has excellent potential. RBB; 2 Amantra Charmette, just 6 months tri, beautiful head, lovely expression, good neck, balanced angulation, still very immature in body & movement, but showed a lot of promise;

- JB (1)1 Headra's Choc A Holic, very elegant blen, most feminine, just a little petit, expressive & typical in head, very good dome, well set ears, good turn-up of underjaw. At 11 months, has a lot of growing up to do, especially in body, but has a very nice outline & moved with balance & light on her feet. Very good coat & colour. PGB (0).

LB (I) I Tewhit Talitha, attractive, typy tri with lots to like, well domed skull, lovely, dark & round eyes, excellent head profile, well set ears, strong neck. Acceptable front standing, but unstable in front movement. Firm back, well developed in body. Prefer less fallaway of croup. Moved quite well from the side, excellent coat. BB. OB (0).
