VD(4,1w/d) 1 Baker's Ch Cofton Never Say Never Again, delightful 8 year old blen, really enjoyed himself, the best mover, true front & back, good chest, body & rib, very nice cushioning, good eyes, small & shapely; 2 Gurtner's Fr/Lux/Bel/Dutch/Int Ch Timothy de Melcourt, tri, I liked his skull & muzzle balance, topline could be better but nice ribbing, good tail action; 3 Salguero's Tewhit Thespian, blen, not just the character of above but in good condition, good skull, nice bone. All 3 much the same age & a credit to their owners.

PD(3) 1 Waters & Robins` Maibee Theo, very nice tri, cobby, well coupled, good rib, nice bone & feet, good head & ears, moved soundly. BP; 2 Mochrie`s Downsbank Spruce, slightly more extrovert than 1 but not just as well bodied or pleasing over the hindquarters, good head shape, nice eyes; 3 House`s Stonepit Mister Adorable at Triciaville, taller blen who needs to strengthen in hindquarters, nice coat, moved out well in front.

JD(8,1) 1 Gillhespy's Tucherish Sundance, free moving b/t, short coupled, ribs carried well back, very good head & eyes,nice cushioning, pleasing outline; 2 Anderson & Watt's Nisyros Cool Hand Luke, tri, very good skull, could have a little more cushioning to match, pleasing neck, shoulders & topline, well coupled, not just the character of 1; 3 Hodges' Marchog Monopoly for Wolverine, b/t, good nostrils & strength in head, needs to firm in pasterns.

YD(9,1) 1 Askins & Kendall's Amantra Charman at Headra,very nice tri, good neck, shoulders, topline & tail, moved very well; 2 Sidgwick's Paulian Paddington JW, blen, some tear staining, nice & sturdy, well set front, good topline, pleasing coat; 3 Moss' Othmese Cole for Sombur, well bodied b/t, nice for size & balance, typical head, nice coat, rich tan, not the outgoing temperament of above.

PGD(12,2) 1 Leach's Amantra Carte Blanche, very pleasing uncomplicated blen, good neck & shoulders, pleasing head with good nose & eyes, in good coat & feathering, moved & showed well; 2 Askins & Kendall's Headra's Chocolate D Lite, pleasing tri of good size, shape & balance,

good head & expression, moved & showed well; 3 Mochrie`s Kumbia Jazzmason, b/t, good head, nice body & rib, pleasing outline, could be a little firmer in pasterns.

LD(14,1) 1 Portingale's Tudorhurst Brigadier, very well bodied b/t, good head, sturdy front with good chest, nice outline & hindquarters, well balanced & looked well on the move. Pressed for a top award; 2 Waters & Robins' Maibee Teddie, good tri, has great character, well made, short coupled & well balanced, just inclined to dip in topline on the move; 3 Gillhespy's Lorphil Copper Sunrise JW, very nice ruby, good head, nice front, steady shower, in lovely coat, needs to fill in a little over the loin.

OD(11,1) 1 Fry & Jackson's Ch Amantra Cheers, top-class tri, good head with very nice finish of chin & cushioning, good eyes & ear leathers, pleasing neck & shoulders, nice firm hindquarters, good coat & condition, moved well keeping his excellent outline. CC & BOB; 2 Stewart's Ch Marchog MacFlannel, nice sturdy dog, good skull & strength in jaw, good body, well ribbed, pleasing limbs, moved out well keeping a level topline, in full coat, good showman. RCC; 3 Anderson & Watt's Maibee Blue Bayou at Nisyros, good b/t, nice size, shapely, not quite the strength in hindquarters of above.

GCD(2) 1 Sidgwick's Paulian Jerome Sh.CM, nice active tri, sturdy, good bone, great character, typical head, moved out well; 2 Price's Paulian Priceless for Almonroy, blen going through a rangy stage, nice firm hindquarters, carries his tail too gaily but has such a lovely happy temperament.

VB(3) 1 Hinson's Kerizma Klassical, really lovely tri of nearly 10, what a character, good for size, shape & movement, pleasing head, in great form; 2 Baker's Cofton Lily The Pink, nice 9-year-old tri, good head & very typical but not as fit as 1 now; 3 Williams' Kasamanda My Fair Lady, bigger tri of 7 years, well made, good coat. PB(5) 1 Waters & Robins' Maibee Emeldamay, quality tri, litter sister to the BP, pleasing head for age, good neck, shoulders & topline, nicely balanced, moved & showed well; 2 Stone's Maynorth Show Me Heaven, b/t who also showed well, pleasing head, good neck, nice legs & feet, good coat. Not just as pleasing in tail; 3

Mochrie`s Downsbank Valentina, young tri who is very promising & when she stood up looked really nice, pleasing head with firm underjaw.

JB(5) 1 Robinson's Baldragon Heaven Scent, attractive active tri, very expressive, nice neck, shoulders & topline, well coupled, moved& showed well; 2 Gillhespy's Tucherish Lucretia Borgia, pleasing b/t of great character, nice typical head,good coat, can improve a little in front; 3 Baker's Cofton My Everlasting Dream, good skull, eves could be a little better, scored in front

YB(11,2) 1 Lewis` Vashdown My Fair Lady, pleasing tri, carrying a little extra weight today but good to see such a good body & rib, pleasing bone, good firm thighs, moved happily; 2 Fox-Shone`s Amantra Charlene, very showy tri, not just as good in eyes on the day, pleasing neck, shoulders & topline, good tail, moved very well; 3 Searle`s Stonepit Penny Royal, very nice face, good neck, shoulders & topline, nice sturdy hindquarters, good coat. Not as good on the move as those above.

PGB(13,3) 1 Branch's Amantra Expresso, small, well bodied sturdy b/t, moved & showed well; 2 Bailey's Maibee Margot at Aldoricka, very showy blen but not as pleasing in eyes today, good finish to muzzle & jaw, well bodied, good over the rump, nice tail; 3 White's Cavella Copper Glow at Joondalup, ruby who was good to go over, nice neck, shoulders & topline, pleasing coat, lacked a little character but moved soundly.

LB(9,1) 1 Waters & Robins` Maibee Olivia, very pleasing sound blen, good head with nice foreface & finish, good eyes, nicely bodied, good coat & condition, moved & showed well; 2 Mochrie`s Downsbank Clarice Cliff, b/t with good unexaggerated eyes & head, not just as pleasing in topline as she could be a little better knit but sound moving & generally pleasing; 3 Goodwin`s Maibee Mamma Mia Diggle, short coupled chunky tri, good skull & ears, very good body & rib, well presented in good coat & feathering, could have moved a little more smoothly & a touch overdone in eyes. OB(13,2) 1 Coupland's Tucherish Michaela, very good b/t, lovely head & ears, good neck, shoulders & front, well bodied, nice hindquarters, sound moving with reach & drive keeping a good topline. CC; 2 Allcock's Amantra Christiania for Sleepyhollow, happy tri, full of character, very typical all through with good body & rib, nice bone & limbs, typical head. RCC; 3 Fry & Jackson's Ch Amantra Winterberry, another lovely tri, good head, pleasing to handle but not completely settled when showing, good body & rib.
