PD (3,1a) 1 Mochrie so Downsbank Spruce, really impressed with this 6 months tri baby at his first show. Correct for bone, lovely cobby body, well domed head, correct turn-up & finish of face, good round dark eye bright tans, short back, good straight front, moved strongly from the rear keeping his topline, enjoyed his day & had the confidence not often seen in such a baby. BP; 2 Hodge so Marchog Monopoly for Wolverine, b/t, lovely head & ear placement, big round dark eye, good pigment, bright tans, moved well. Longer in back than 1.

JD (3) 1 Fry & Jackson s Amantra Chieftain, lovely blen, well broken markings, good colour on pearly white silky coat which was just starting to show length. Superb apple head, correct turn-up & finish of face, good neck & shoulders on a short cobby body, ample bone, moved with confidence showing his excellent front & strong rear movement; 2 Askin s Amantra Charman at Headra, really liked this young tri, reminded me of his father. A bit skittish on the table, my fault, no don t think so. Lovely dome & finish of face, big round dark eye, excellent pigment, good reach of neck on well laid back shoulder, short cobby body, good bone, moved with drive; 3 Robinson s Baldragon Hooray Henley.

PGD (6,1) 1 Mochrie S Kumbia Jazzmason, fresh blood for the whole colours. B/t, my favourite of all 4 colours & because of this tend to be more critical of them. Masculine head, well domed, good turn-up & finish of face, darkest of eye which were big round, soft & melting, no coarseness here, good reach of neck & shoulders short backed, good bone, soft silky coat with bright tans, moved well, showing his good front & topline. RCC; 2 Naylor S Maenan Moon Blaze, lovely tri, lovely head, correct dome & finish of face, big round dark eye so important for that soft expression, good pigment, short backed, good bone, good front & strong back movement, moved

with confidence & drive keeping his topline on the move, happy temperament & enjoyed his day; 3 Essex, Fry & Jackson s Amantra Oliver Twist.

- LD (3) 1 Waters & Robin s Maybee Louix, blen, lovely head that is well known to this kennel, typical of his breeding. Big strong & masculine, good finish & turn-up, good pigment, good shoulders, short backed, good bone, well broken markings on pearly white silky coat. A little larger in size but we can thave everything. A little bit reluctant at first but showed that he can move when he puts his mind to it; 2 Goodwin s Tucherish Stanley Diggle, very hard decision between these two dogs & I am sure they will change places many times. Lovely head & finish of face, good ear placement, long leathers, good pigment, bright tans, well broken straight silky coat, moved with confidence showing his good straight front & strong rear movement, lovely showy boy; 3 Austin s Baldragon Big It Up.
- OD (4) 1 Fry & Jackson s Amantra Cheers, when looking at a Charlie what do we look for in our BOB? Head, coat, pigment, movement, confidence. Well this boy has it all, a pleasure to have the chance to go over him. Excels in head, cushioning & finish of face, lovely dark round eye, blackest of pigment, long silky straight coat, long ear leathers, crested neck on good shoulders, short backed, good bone, moved as he should with confidence & drive, shows himself & he loves it. Just gives his all, at one with his confident handler, no nerves here. A pleasure to watch. Could go on but has all been said before. CC, BOB & shortlisted in the group. Worthy of this name; 2 Moss Ch Amantra Dickens with Sombur, trie, a worthy ch, very much like 1. Loved him as a youngster, good strong head & finish, well filled under the eye, darkest of pigment, good bright tans, short backed, good front & bone. Unlucky to meet 1 in his crowning glory. Thought this was my RCC winner but wasn tas strong in rear movement in the final line-up; 3 Waters & Robin ch Rytonian Out Of The Blue.
- VB (1) 1 Williams Kasamanda My Little Madam, what a show girl, 8 years young & still loving her day out. Doesn took her age, no white hairs. Just shows this breed are better as they

mature. Lovely head, darkest of eyes, good pigment, well broken markings on long silky coat, moved well keeping her topline.

- PB (3) 1 Baker S Cofton Ruby Ruby Ruby, lovely ruby baby as the name states. So rich in colour but coat yet to come. Like all ruby s takes time & patience, the slowest to mature. Lovely head but needs time to finish. Crested neck, so short backed with good ribcage, straight front & good strong angulated back movement, moved with confidence. Would love to see her again in 12 months time; 2 Goodwin Lanola Amy Winehouse, just like her namesake, naughty but nice. A little madam on the table. Well domed tri, good finish of face, dark eye, good pigment, brightest of tans, good reach of neck & shoulders, short backed, good bone. Took time to settle but when she did moved well. Good front & back movement; 3 Mochrie Downsbank Valentina. JB (3) 1 Baker Cofton Share My Dream, lovely dome, good ear placement, correct turn up & finish of face, good dark pigment, well laid back shoulders on short cobby body, moved well keeping her topline at all times, long silky coat; 2 Williams Kasamanda Waltzing Matilda, good head & pigment, well finished in face, good bone, short cobby body, moved well, good topline; 3 Williams Kasamanda My Lady Fayre.
- PGB (7,2) 1 Goodwin s Maibee Mamma Mia Diggle, lovely tri, correct dome, good ear placement & long silky leathers, right turn-up & cushioning, blackest of noses & super big dark round eye, crested neck on well laid shoulders, short cobby body, good ribs, short backed, well boned, good markings on straight silky coat, straight front, good strong rear, level topline, moved with confidence, looked so well, quite a show girl. RCC; 2 Junipor s Kasamanda Luck Be A Lady at Lewiscarol, lovely tri, lovely head & finish of face, big round dark eye, blackest of noses, good shoulders & front, cobby body, good ribs, moved well keeping her topline at all times. Just needs coat to complete the picture, keep trying she is worth it; 3 Harvey s Rocquencourt Rosetta Royal at Rivermoor.
- LB (7,1) 1 Goodwin s Lanola Morenta, a favourite of mine, happy, showy b/t, lovely head, the darkest of eyes, good turn-up & finish of face, jet black nose, good reach of neck on well laid

shoulders, short cobby body, good bone, straight front, good rear movement, moved with drive keeping her topline, coat coming back after her litter, an honest bitch with nothing to hide; 2 Harvey&s Lankcombe Gabriella at Rivermoor, lovely bitch, well marked tri, long silky coat, well domed head, good finish of face, darkest of eyes & nose pigment, short cobby body, good ribcage & ample bone, moved with confidence. Just preferred front of 1; 3 Stone&s Maynorth Irresistible. OB (6) 1 Waters & Robin&s Maibee Leah, last saw her as a puppy & has she come on. What a little gem, she just oozes quality. Beautiful domed head, so feminine, lovely finish of face, big round dark eye, good pigment, brightest of tans on pearly white coat, so short & compact, crested neck on well laid shoulders, well boned, good ribcage, good front & topline, moved with confidence, well handled, short on coat but nothing to hide, looked a picture. Just loved her. CC; 2 Gurtner&s Int/Lux/Bel/Dutch/Sw Ch Veryan D&Ahotep, lovely tri, good in head & finish of face, well filled, dark eye, good pigment, bright tans, moved well showing her excellent movement, short on coat, sound bitch; 3 Stone&s Maynorth Simply Heavenly.
