Black & Tan. Excellent body with spring of rib & deep chest, well cushioned head with dark eye. Moved freely & well presented. Best Puppy.

JD (1) 1 Askins & Kendall's Amantra Charman At Headra. Well broken tri. In good coat, well bodied level back moved freely.

PGD (6) 1 Naylor's Maenan Moon Blaze. Tri colour well broken. Just loved his size, short backed, pleasing head with dark eye and dome. Moved well & freely RCC. 2 Askins & Kendall's Headra's Chocolate D Lite. Slightly larger than 1 well bodied very happy moved & showed well. 3 Portingale's Tudorhurst Matador.

LD (5,2) 1 Smith's Ageancourt Magic Once More Is Justacharma. Tri-colour. Well bodied free mover, one I have judged before. 2 East's Nastane Tommy. Another I have judges before very happy free mover good head and nose placement. 3 Randle & Pritchards' Lillijay Debonair Digby.

OD (6) 1 Stewart's Ch Marchog Macflannel. Ruby in pristine condition and presentation second to none, beautiful correct coat of correct texture. Well cushioned head with rise and dark eye. Well

bodied with deep chest. Very much in tune with his handler move around the ring so free and effortlessly. CC & Best of Breed. 2 Fry & Jackson's Ch Amantra Cheers. Well known tri-colour in good coat, well bodied with level back, moved well around the ring. 3 Portingale's Tudorhurst Brigadier.

MPB (4) 1 Fry & Jackson's Maynorth Chocolate Heaven Amantra Naf Taf. Black & Tan with beautiful head, excellent dome, moved out well, needs more body but just a baby yet. 2 Mochrie's Downsbank Valentina. Tri-colour. Well broken, good body with level back, good head with dark eyes, not too happy on the move she was feeling the cold & boy was it cold in that ring! 3 Stone's Maynorth Show Me Heaven.

PB (2) 1 Baker's Cofton Ruby Ruby Ruby Ruby. Most glorious coloured Ruby, nice size with good body, well filled head and finish of mouth, dark eye and dome. Moved freely. 2 Hunter's Hooebarton Aurora. Tri-colour very much a baby needs more body, very skittish but this will improve with time.

JB (2,1) 1 Lewis's Vashdown My Fair Lady. Well broken Tri-colour, free mover, would like more rise in the head otherwise a pleasing head. Well bodied & level back.

PGB (5) 1 Naylor's Maenan Moon Angel. Well broken Tri-colour, of good size, nice reach of neck, level back well finished head with lovely eye & soft expression, good body, steady mover. 2 Pearson's Headras Choc A Holic. Blenheim smaller than 1, good body sound free mover. 3 Baker's Cofton Roxyheart.

LB (4,1) 1 Coupland's Tucherish Wkd Antoinette. Tri-colour which scored highly in head qualities beautiful rise to scull and dark eye which gave a soft pleasing expression, excellent spring of rib & depth of chest, level back and well angulated rear legs which moved with

drive, this was my ideal size a Toy Spaniel pleased to award CC. 2 Stone's Maynorth Irresistible JW. Another tri-colour who I had judged previously as a puppy, just longer in the body than 1 otherwise has matured well. 3 Loynd's Crimbledale Solitaire.

OB (6,2) 1 Mochrie's Downsbank Julietta. Tri-color, with a great body, full head and dark eye won this class on conformation and size RCC. 2 Pearson's Ch Tewhit Talitha. Tri-color, worthy champion, good body moved freely just that bit larger than 1. 3 Loynd's Crimbledale Solitaire.
