- 1. Smith s Justacharma Now He is Magic Small lightly marked compact Blenheim who moved and showed with great assurance for one so young. Typical blenheim head with good dome,dark eye and and good ear-set. Short straight back, good angulation both in shoulder and stifle. Good bone, totally balanced, plenty of coat. Moved very well.BPIB 2. Austins Baldragon Big it Up. Nicely marked tricolour, attractive head with dark eye and nicely cushioned fore-face good dome and bright tan. Well made with short cobby body. Moved well.

- 2. Askin s Headra s Black Coffee, black/tan, very mature for age. Bright tan, plenty of coat, showed with great confidence. I just preferred the compactness of my winner. Junior Dog (4,1) Not the easiest of classes to judge as they were all playing up in one way or another.
- 1. Moger s Gayhalo Black Sabbath Black/tan made in a small mould. Pretty head with dark expressive eye and rich tan. Good reach of neck, well laid back shoulders and level topline when on the move. Unfortunately he nearly threw it all away with his refusal to stand but on balance I still preferred him.

- 2 Ponner s Nastane Merry. Very masculine blenheim with pleasant apple head. Good reach of neck, well laid back shoulders and depth of chest. A little long cast in body. Shown in good coat. Moved soundly.
- 3. Blewett & Smith so Othmese Celtic Royale
  Post Graduate Dog(10,1) A good class with very little to separate the first two.
- 1. Bott s Mistycote Amos I last judged this dog as a puppy and how well he has matured since then. Tricolour having lovely head with well rounded skull, broad muzzle, dark eye, rich tan and good ear set. Well constructed with rounded rib cage, well laid back shoulders and well angulated rear quarters. Moved very well. He just needs more coat to put him in contention for top honours.
- 2. Portingale s Tudorhurst Brigadier. Most attractive black/tan. Good foreface and rich tan. Short cobby body with good bone. Looked very well balanced in profile with level topline, good shoulders and sound movement. Put down to perfection with straight silky coat.
- 3 Smith s Ageancourt Magic Once More is Justacharma Limit Dog.(10,1)This was, without doubt, my class of the day. The first two were just what I was looking for in size and type
- 1. Fry s Check Mate Amantra. Super headed tricolour having good broad skull and well cushioned fore-face. Bright tan, dark expressive eye and well set on ears. Correct size with short body, good depth and width of chest, well laid shoulder and good rear angulation. Shown in good coat. Obviously enjoying his day out, he moved and showed with confidence. - 2 Plews Tewhit Tedward Bear Whole-colours, generally speaking, take longer to mature and this little ruby boy is now coming into his own Most attractive head with good dome, dark eye, good breadth of skull and muzzle Overall well balanced, with plenty of substance, short cobby body, well rounded stifle. Strode out with terrific drive. RCC.
- 3 Rushton�s Tiflin Tudor Royal JW Open Dog (4,1)
- 1. Plews Ch. Tewhit Typhoon. Upstanding tri-colour with excellent head qualities, lovely dome, well cushioned fore-face, good pigment and well defined markings. Well constructed and moved very well with strong driving action. A very worthy champion but in the Challenge I felt that a little more body would have completed the picture.

  2 Askin S Headra Chocolate Box. I loved the head on this black/tan with expressive dark eye, bright tan and alert expression. Shown in lovely condition with straight silky coat. Well constructed with good shoulder placement and deep brisket. Very happy-golucky temperament, completely in tune with his handler.. Unlucky to come up against one of the best movers of the day.
- 3 Blewett & Smith s Ch Othmese Celtic Chant Minor Puppy Bitch (5,0) This was a lovely class of very promising puppies. The first three, in particular, will change places on other days. Today, I was only able to split them on maturity.

- 1, Robinson s Nastane Miss Dior avec Baldragon. Tri-clour with lovely typey head, good rich tan, nicely marked, well balanced overall. Moved well with confidence and showed happily.
- 2 Askin s Amantra Charmful at Headra Much the same as my first, splitting hairs to say that she didn t have quite the rapport with her handler but I m sure that this will improve and then her day will come..
- 3 Allcock s Amantra Christiana for Sleepyhollow Puppy Bitch(4,1)
- 1. Blewett & Smith s Othmese Celtic Hester. Extra exhuberant tri-colour, very mature for her age with a profuse coat in superb condition. Attractive head with good tan and dark eye, showing cheeky expression. Well bodied with broad spring of rib, deep brisket and nicely angulated stifle. Moved with great confidence.
- 2 Allcock s Amantra Chartreuse Nicely balanced Blenheim with typical apple head, ears well placed framing the face. Nice finish of fore-face. Good bone for size with level topline. Needs to mature.
- 3 Ireland Cooks s Charnell Dietrich
- Junior Bitch (6,3) 1. Blewett & Smith so Othmese Dhu Melyonen. Black/tan, very harum scarum on the table but settled well enough for me to appreciate her very pretty head with large expressive eyes, good rich tan and broad muzzle. Short cobby body, moved with great confidence.
- 2 Mallows Lorphil Copper Delight Binglui. Ruby with lovely domed head and large dark eye. Well constructed with good angulation both fore and rear. Excellent topline which

accentuated her outline when moving Showed happily. Possible a little more body would complete the picture.

3 Williams Kasamanda Lady be Good

Post Graduate Bitch (6,1) 1. Stone s Maynorth Twice as Spice. Richly coloured ruby girl with attractive head. Well rounded dome, large expressive eyes and full fore-face. Correct nose and ear placement. Well constructed with good reach of neck and well laid back shoulders, short back and good rear angulation. Showed and moved well. 2 Williams Kasamanda My Sweet Charity. Tri-colour of nice size, attractively marked.. Lovely dome and fore-face. Short coupled body with level top-line. Well made with good bone, moved well with confidence.

- 3 Dix@s Lorphil Black Lace for Beewye Limit Bitch (6,2)
- 1. Harvey s Rivermoor Violet. Tri-colour with lovely head, well domed, broad cushioned muzzle, dark expressive eyes and well placed ears. Excellent conformation with good reach of neck, well laid shoulders, short level back, deep chested, good spring of rib and well angulated of stifle. The best mover in the class. BCC
- 2 Hardiman s Cofton Razzle Dazzle Em over Tovarich. Attractive headed tri-colour with broad skull and fore-face well cushioned Short cobby body, good bone, well angulated quarters Overall a most pleasing picture but just needs to show herself off a little more.
- 3 Mallows Lorphil Copper Cobana Binglui Open Bitch (3,0)

- 1. Stone s Maynorth in Seventh Heaven. A black/tan, well named because I found her simply heavenly. Rich tan, good dome and well cushioned muzzle but it was all in the eyes resembling limpid pools, they gave her the softest of expressions. Correct size, with good bone, cobby body, good spring of rib and deep brisket. Good neck and shoulders and well angulated rear quarters.RCC
- 2 Blewett & Smith S Othmese Due Steren. Tri-colour S another with a lovely head, good dome, broad skull and foreface and well cushioned under the eye. Excellent nose and ear placement. Short cobby body with good spring of rib, deep chest and good bone. Moved happily and soundly but today tended to lose her topline when moving.
